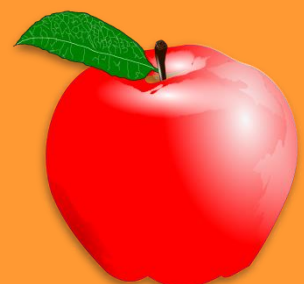

SECURITY AROUND THE SCHOOL



Thank you for your patience during the upgrading of our security around school. We are sorry if it has caused some inconvenience when trying to access the school office.

Can I remind you that the main access for parents is always through the village hall gate, unless visiting the main school during the day. The village hall gate will be open in the mornings and at the end of the day to allow access into the school to collect children and the side gate will also be open at these times to allow you to come around to the office if necessary. Both gates will be locked between 9.20am and 3pm. The village hall gate will continue to be unlocked for a short time at lunch time, to allow collecting from pre-school at lunch time, but should not be used if you need to get to the main office at that time.
