

National Curriculum

In English we will read a variety of poems and then write our own 'Senses' poems and then move onto other poems linked to animals found in the jungle and the weather. We will continue to investigate sentence structure and parts of speech, including using nouns, verbs and adjectives, to improve our writing quality. We will practise using conjunctions such as; **and**, **also** and **but**, to help extend, our writing. We will continue to practice our handwriting.

In Maths we will learn about:

- *Number: one more/one less/10 more and 10 less with numbers up and possibly over 100. We will look at the place value of the 2 digit numbers*
- *Multiplication and Division: focusing on groups of and sharing into groups of amounts and using in simple everyday problems such as shopping*
- *Time : focusing on o'clock and half past and hour*
- *Fractions: looking at halves and quarters*
- *Measurment: using liquids to emeasure capacity*
- *Addition and Subtraction using numbers up to 20 and then 100.*

As Scientists we will observe and talk about changes in the weather and the seasons. We will find out about day length, as the seasons change. We will find out about plants; we will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees & identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

LEARNING TO LEARN.

We will encourage the children to be **reflective learners**, considering the impact of their attitude, effort and actions.

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As Geographers, we will begin the term learning about a wetter region in the world and find out all about the climate in a jungle as well as the animals

In DT - make instruments to use with our Samba Music made from plastic bottles and pots, metal tins etc

As Musicians we will learning about the different rythmns in Samba music and begin to compose our own Samba pieces and make some instruments that can be used in our own Samba Band.

In RE, to look at how we should care for the world and look after others

In PSHE we will be discussing about keeping ourselves safe following our visit from the Air Ambulance.

Indoor PE we will listen to South American Music and then create a Dance linked to the rainforests environment.

Outdoor PE- we will be learning the skills needed for tennis. Learning to control the ball with the racket and improving or aim using the net

In computing we will be learning how to use a word processing program using the laptops, learning to type using the keyboard
